Did you know that nearly half of all K-12 students in Adams 14 are English Language Learners?

At this forum, parents and community members will learn about how the district is supporting students in achieving academic success through English language development (ELD) programs such as: K-3 Biliteracy, the Newcomer program at Kearney Middle School and the Seal of Biliteracy pathway at Adams City High School.

Participants will learn about federal and state law, review Adams 14 student achievement data, and engage in table discussions regarding the district's English language development programs.

Parents will also hear about the Superintendent's ELD Advisory Committee and how they can apply to be a part of the committee to further study ELD programming in Adams 14.

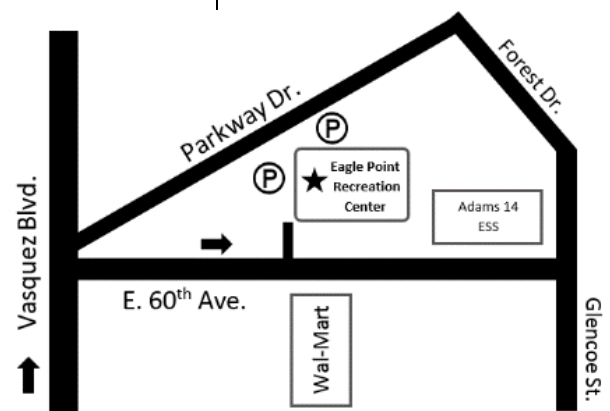
