School Accountability Laws

Senate Bill SB 09-163

State Accountability Act of 2009

- Every school must have a School Accountability Committee and every district must have a District Accountability Committee
- Committee must have parent representation
- Parent participants must reflect the demographics of the student body
- Other legislation:
 - READ ACT
 - ICAP

Senate Bill 13-193

Increasing Parent Engagement in Public Schools

- Publicize opportunities for parents to serve on the School Accountability Committees



SENATE BILL 13-193

CONCERNING DECREASING PARENT ENGAGEMENT IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-11-302, **amend** (1) introductory portion, (1) (e), and (1) (f); and **add** (1) (g) as follows:

22-11-302. School district accountability committee - powers and duties. (1) Each school district accountability committee ~~shall have~~ HAS the following powers and duties:

(c) To consider input and recommendations from the school accountability committee of each school of the school district to facilitate the evaluation of the performance of the school's principal for the purposes of article 9 of this title; **and**

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; *italics* through *revoked* indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

DAAC RESPONSIBILITIES

Statutory requirement for every school district, Colorado Revised Statute 22-11-302

- Make **recommendations** to the local school board on:
 - 1) Priorities for spending school district moneys
 - 2) The content and preparation of the district's Unified Improvement Plan
- Provide input to the local school board on the creation and enforcement of its school conduct and discipline code.
- Review charter school applications and upon district request and DAAC option, review any renewal application prior to the school board.
- At least annually, collaborate with the school board to determine areas and issues, upon which the DAAC shall study and make recommendations.

DAAC RESPONSIBILITIES

Statutory requirement for every school district, Colorado Revised Statute 22-11-302

- Provide input and make **recommendations** to principals on the development and use of assessment tools to evaluate student academic growth as it relates to teacher evaluations.
- Publicize opportunities to serve and solicit parents to serve on the DAAC and BAAC.
- Assist district in implementing the district's family engagement policy to increase family engagement
- Assist school personnel to increase families' engagement with educators, including family engagement in creating students' READ plans, individual Career and Academic Plans and plans to address habitual truancy.
