

Walkers and Riders

The district shall furnish transportation to all elementary school students who live beyond one mile from their assigned school, to middle school students who live beyond one and one-half miles from their assigned school, to high school students who live beyond two miles from their assigned school, and to students who are attending a school other than their assigned school pursuant to the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) choice option. In no event shall students be required to walk more than one-half (.5) mile to the bus stop.

Transportation shall be furnished for shorter distances if, in the opinion of the Board, extreme hardship or dangerous conditions prevail.

Measurement of Walking Distances

1. Distance will be measured only over public thoroughfares. The beginning point of measurement at the school shall be the nearest point of the sidewalk in front of the main building.
2. Measurement will be made via the most direct route to the nearest center of the individual's land parcel bordering public thoroughfares.

If traffic hazards or other unusual conditions jeopardize the safety of students, the COO or Transportation Manager may approve exceptions to the above.

Short term ill or disabled students that do not qualify for an IEP or under the terms of this policy may be transported temporarily. Each specific case shall be subject to the approval of the COO or Transportation Manager.
