OUR PARTNERSHIP

13 years, and counting!

- **2007** – Launched Suncor Boys & Girls Club in Adams 14's Kearney Middle School.
- **2015** – Collaborative efforts resulted in the building of a custom-designed Club facility just down the street from Kearney, doubling the Club's capacity.
- **Today** – our partnership serves over 600 Club children annually, with 140 in attendance each day.



MEETING THE NEED

Why Out-of-School-Time Programs?

1. After school, unsupervised kids may engage in risky behaviors.
2. Youth access to enrichment activities is highly dependent on family income.
3. Low-income students trail substantially behind more affluent peers, especially academically.

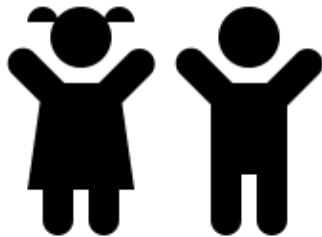

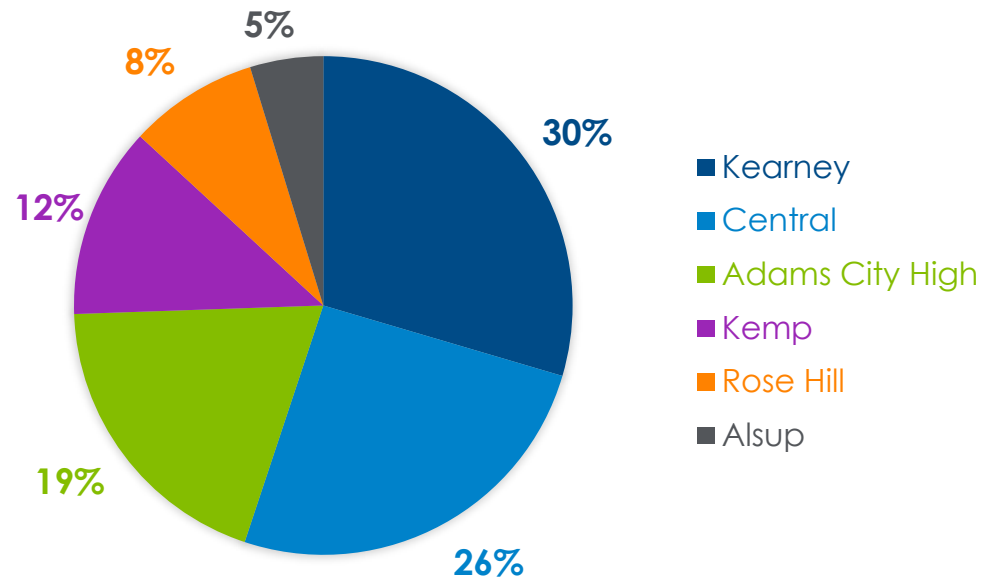

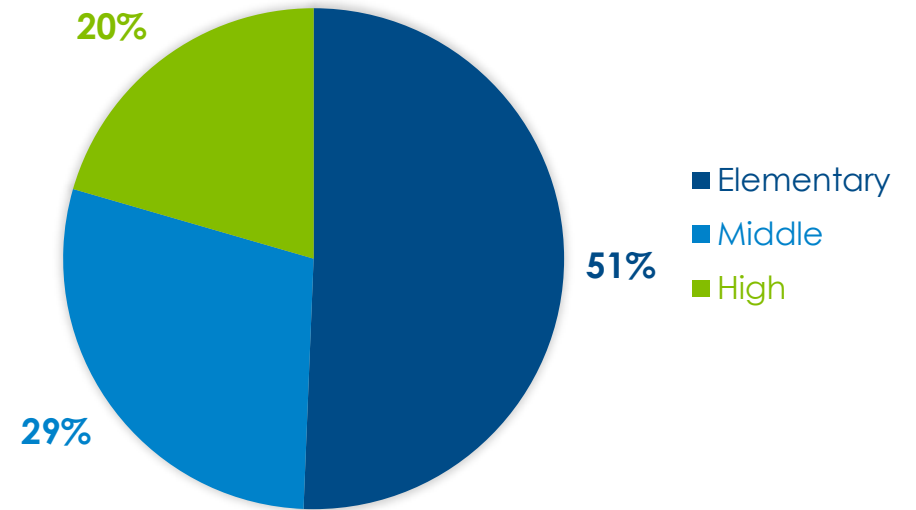

STUDENTS WHO ATTEND REGULARLY...

PERFORM BETTER IN SCHOOL

- 80% believe that the things they learn in school will be important later in life.
- 80% earn mostly A's and B's in school.
- Senior Club members graduate from high school at a rate higher than their peers



BECOME THE LEADERS OF TOMORROW

- 87% said they would stand up for what is right, even if their friends disagreed.
- 85% spend time on projects with other people to help their community.
- 95% try to help when they see people in need.



LIVE HEALTHY LIVES

- 90% exercise for at least 60 minutes at least twice per week.
- 89% ate three or more fruits/vegetables per day.
- 75% know ways to calm themselves down.

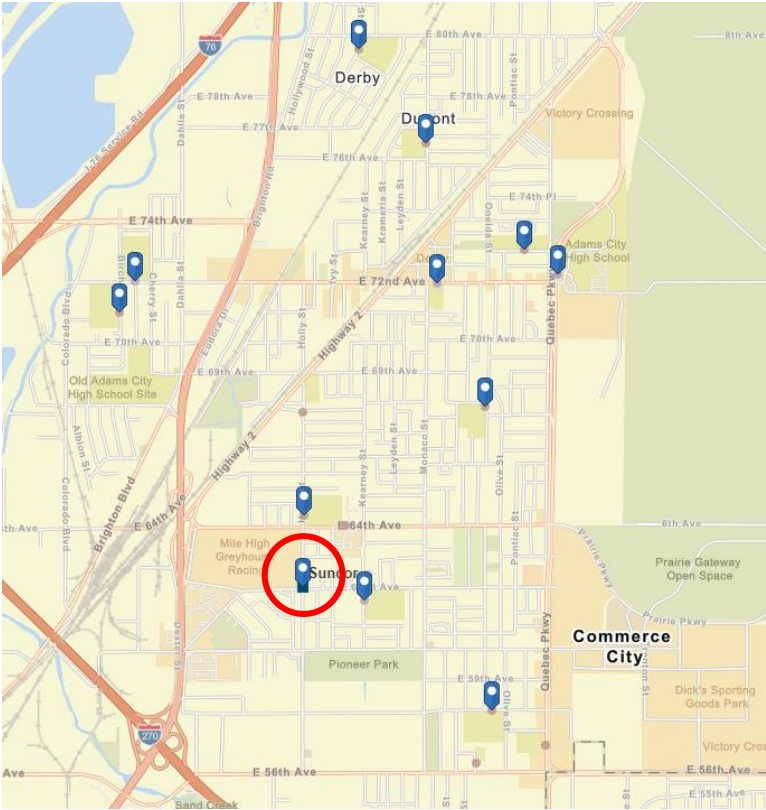
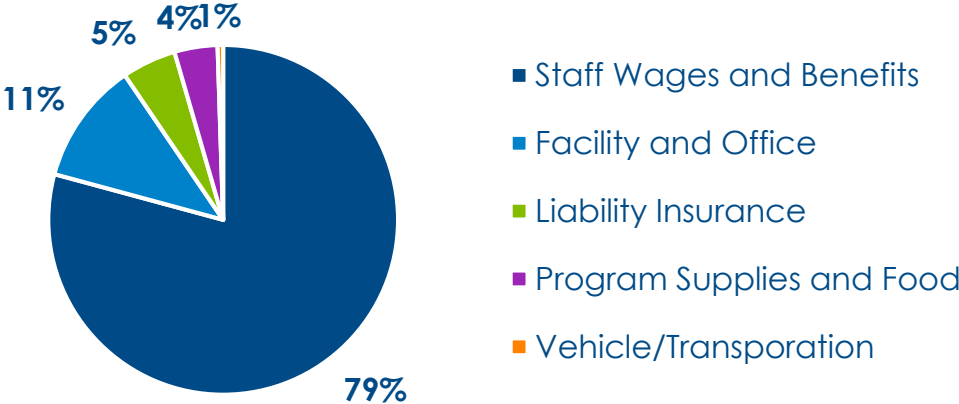
