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Model of Staffing Needs



Student Needs

- Maintain Current Positions directly connected to students' needs
- Address declining enrollment and keep staffing cuts way from classrooms

Types of Positions

- Not just a blanket FTE per building
- Students' needs versus staffing
- Flexible Staffing Options



Curriculum

Create Curriculum Standing Committee

- DAC would like to see consistency and maximum usage of materials
- A strong mental health component or its own curriculum
- Charged with
 - Process for Adoption (budget parameters)
 - Reviews/Recommendations (for new curriculum if needed)
 - Replacement Recommendations
 - Evaluation/Accountability
- Who:
 - Both Parents/Teachers
 - Pre-K 12 Representation
 - District wide focus



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Special Populations We Serve And Technology Supports

- Individual Educational Plans (IEP)
- Advance Learning Plans/Gifted and Talented (ALP)
- English Language Learners (ELL)
 - DAC recommends that services are inclusive to meet the students' needs
 - Resources provided support need
 - Evaluations of students' abilities and needs versus staffing generalities

<u>Post-COVID-19 Technology budget increase</u> for home learning - goal to confront inequities and making sure eqitable access id provided.
