WHEREAS, Credit Recovery will be offered as a course to high school students during summer programming who have one or more "F's" earned on students transcripts or for students who are looking for credit advancement; and

WHEREAS, Adams 14 students and families will be charged a \$25.00 fee to participate in the Credit Recovery Course at registration; and

WHEREAS, The Credit Recovery Program will be offered from June 3, 2019 through June 27, 2019 at Adams City High School, Lester Arnold High School, Adams City Middle School (incoming 9th graders) and Kearney Middle School (incoming 9th graders); and

WHEREAS, The student fees will only be charged for the Credit Recovery Course during the program time period. Fees collected for Credit Recovery will be deposited into a Credit Recovery Fund that will be used to host future Credit Recovery Courses.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of Adams County School District 14, Adams County, State of Colorado, does hereby approve charging a \$25 fee for the Credit Recovery Program in Adams 14.

Della Palacios, District Gifted and Talented Coordinator requests approval to apply for \$58,717.79, in funding from the Universal Screening and Qualified Personnel Grant from the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) to support gifted and talented identification and programming throughout the district.

The funding from this grant will focus on identifying students in underrepresented populations and fund .5 of the Gifted and Talented Coordinator's salary to sustain and grow programming for gifted and talent pool students in Adams 14.

Additionally, the funding will be used to purchase materials and supplies needed for testing of all 2nd and 6th grade students. This grant is intended to improve gifted identification of underrepresented students and appropriate educational programming for those students. The period of this grant is July, 2019-June, 2020.

Adams 14 has been given a financial gift of \$14,180.00 from Salud Family Health Centers.

Salud has specifically delegated this money to offset costs for the District in health related programming. Student services has completed a brief sponsorship narrative identifying how these funds will be spent. Specifically, the District will update twenty five year old vision and hearing screening equipment and purchase AED devices for schools.

Salud currently provides no-cost dental treatment for all students in Adams 14. First semester of the 2018-2019 school year Salud Family Health Center provided services to 2,600 students and placed 4,559 sealants. The value of these services to our students is \$340,000.00.
